

Policy on Occupational Risk Prevention

This policy is defined on the basis of the fundamental principle of protecting the life, integrity and health of all employees, both their own and collaborating enterprises, as well as safeguarding working conditions and the environment where work is carried out. in which it is developed. Establishing the following

Commitments

Prevent accidents at work, for which it has the necessary precautionary means and measures.

Prevention integration. Designation of the command line as responsible for the prevention of occupational hazards.

Establish the prevalence of **damage prevention** and impairment to health **over the productive activity**.

Investment. Investing in security is profitable; it improves quality, increases productivity and saves costs.

Compliance with legal requirements. Identify, disseminate and ensure strict compliance with national and international laws, regulations and standards related to occupational safety and health, applicable to the company and to the projects and Works we are engaged in, as well as any other commitments undertaken by the company from time to time.

Training. To train, encourage and make the most of the employees and foster their sense of responsibility.

Participation. To Foster active participation of the employees and people working on behalf of the company in developing of Health and Safety Management System.

Communication and consultation. To implement the necessary communication and consultation channels with all employees.

Continuous improvement. Continuously improve the effectiveness of the Health and Safety Management System, the procedures and performance relating to health and safety, based on the results from audits, statistical analysis and data, corrective and preventive measures and other sources of improvement.

Management undertakes to ensure that this Policy is understood, implemented and maintained, for which it has the necessary resources.

It is the responsibility of the entire company to comply with the provisions of the Prevention Plan and the principles defined in this policy, which is the reference framework for establishing and periodically reviewing the company's **objectives** at all levels with the aim of ensure efficiency and evaluating performance of the Health and Safety management system.

For this purpose, the Management has contracted an External Health and Safety Service and has created in parallel the Integrated Management Systems Department, which includes the Occupational Risks Prevention Unit in compliance with RD 39/1997. Management entrusts the Integrated Management Systems Director, who has the necessary authority and independence, for implementing and ensuring compliance with the Health and Safety management system.
